### **Councillor Report - Kelvin Galbraith**

35 Plains Road east – opposite solid gold – 12 storey mixed use 161 residential – underground parking and commercial retail – pre application meeting

484 Plains Road - Proposed Changes to National Homes Site: Proposed Development Concerning the Phase 2 lands, National Homes (Plains Road) LP is proposing a minor adjustment to the permitted unit distribution. More affordable units. No height changes.

- Adjusting the overall number of stacked back-to-back townhouse units from 110 to 81; a reduction in 29 townhouse units;
- Increase in the number of residential condominium units in Phase 2 from 124 to 166 units; an overall increase from 277 to 319 units
- Unique central park space and parking, events space potential

1200 King – open house community – Wednesday June 26<sup>th</sup> – 4/7p crossroads – another walking tour board invite – Wednesday July 3rd (1p)

MTSA – deferred several months

Amendment to the city zoning bylaw – province encourage minimum parking removal on Fairview, Plains road, Appleby line – places like Downsview district, MTSA parking minimum

- 35 plans road will have a 0.68 ratio
- Applies to residential portion only / still service and visitor
